General rules

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General Outlines

Since 1957, and every 4 years, amateur theatre lovers from all around the world are gathered together, in Monaco, to compare their techniques and their approach to the theatre and to exchange ideas revolving around a mutual passion.

The aim of the Mondial du Theatre is to host a variety of performances, reflecting cultural differences within the international amateur theatre community as well as displaying an exceptional panorama of high quality amateur theatre talent throughout the world.

Thus, the Festival contributes to the “theatre as a means of comprehension and education” which are the aims of the International Association of Amateur Theatre (aita-iata asbl) whose Official Festival it is.

The Festival is organised around three main themes : confrontation, exchanges and teaching.

*The presentation of high quality artistic performances constitutes the **CONFRONTATION**. Each company represents its own country and its own amateur theatre, with preferably a complete, original or modern performance, not lasting more than 60 minutes. In accordance with the spirit of aita-iata status, the groups are invited to present shows accentuating cultural differences, scenic forms and dramatic expression.*

The Festival, actual “photo finish” of world amateur theatre offers a synthesis of its various trends and encourages encounters between theatre lovers (actors, producers and spectators).

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*Colloques are privileged places for **EXCHANGES**. These colloques are held, the day following each performance ; they are run by members of the Permanent Artistic Committee of IATA and by professional theatre critics. They allow all festival-goers, as well as the audience to debate on the theatrical practicalities of the company – choice of themes, production, acting, techniques, etc – on the company itself – its origins, history, repertoire, socio-professional integration and representation, etc – as well as on the organisation and the development of amateur theatre in the country it represents.*

TEACHING is imparted by means of various international workshops of high standard. They are organised with the cooperation of the Permanent Artistic Committee of the International Amateur Theatre Association and the Francophone Agency, in order to satisfy the educational, cultural and artistic vocation of the Festival.

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*The **Mondial du Théâtre**, world festival of amateur theatre, under the high patronage of His Serene Highness Prince Albert II, is held exclusively in Monaco every 4 years.*

By decision of the 3rd congress of IATA/AITA, held in Monaco on 13th and 14th September 1957, the responsibility for the organisation is entrusted to the Studio de Monaco, a monegasque artistic amateur theatre circle founded in 1939, and creator of this event.

*In accordance with a decision taken on 10th September 1957 between the Board of Directors of IATA/AITA and the Board of Directors of the Studio de Monaco, the attribute of the title **MONDIAL** as well as the title **Mondial du Théâtre** are the exclusive property of the Festival which is the official festival of the International Amateur Theatre Association – IATA/AITA.*

Since 1981, the Festival benefits from the effective support of U.N.E.S.C.O. It is also an “associated event” of the technical and cultural cooperation agency, which became in 1977, the Francophone Agency.

An international committee of actors and authors of notoriety, under the Presidency of H.R.H. Princess Caroline, and an honorary committee under the Presidency of H.S.H. Princess Antoinette grouping prominent people from Monaco, contribute by their discerning interest to the enhancement of this event.

In accordance with decisions taken by the 10th congress of IATA/AITA, held from August 26th to 29th 1971, in Västeras (Sweden), the general concept of the Festival is left to the responsibility of the Joint Committee which deliberates on all important questions. This Joint Committee is composed of members from the Executive Board of IATA/AITA and from the Organisation Committee.

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*In accordance with an IATA/AITA decision, the **Mondial du Theatre**, does not make any classification, nor does it give any prizes or money awards. Participation in the Festival itself is the highest award an amateur company can receive, and each company is given, as a testimony of their participation, a special “Hommage du Festival”, consisting of a bronze sculpture.*

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Participation

The number of participating countries is constantly on the increase, as one festival succeeds another. At the first event in 1957 there were 11 countries. Since 1973, each festival welcomes over 20 countries.

At least 18 invitations are reserved for countries affiliated to aita-iata. Furthermore, the participation of countries, non members of aita-iata, enables them to form a rapprochement with this International Association, thereby enhancing its development.

The Congress of the International Amateur Theatre Association (aita-iata asbl) is also held during the festival. Delegates and observers from over 70 countries meet in Monaco during this event. The chart below conveys an idea of the number of participants (either to the festival, to the congress, or as observers...) during the last two festivals. It shows the economic impact of such an event on the local economy.

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Main events

Colloques

Organisation : Daily sessions every morning from 10.00 a.m to 12.30 a.m, on 29th, 30th, 31st July and on 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th August 2005.

Purpose : By assembling festival-goers and members of the 3 companies having performed the night before, these meetings aim at exchanging information on the working methods of these companies, in relation to theatre practises of their own countries. Public participation is most welcome.

Chairpersons: Jacques LEMAIRE, former President of Iata/Aita, President of the session; Luc COLIN, professor and theatre critic in Belgium ; Oslin BOEKHOUDT, member of Iata/Aita Centre in Aruba.

Main topics to be discussed :

- 1. History of the company**
- 2. Artistic goals and aims of the company**
- 3. Company life and organisation**
- 4. Creation process of the company**
- 5. Cultural context in which the company lives in its own country.**
- 6. Relations of the company with the National Centre of aita-iata as well as on international level.**

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Workshops

Organisation : 3 workshops, with 4 sessions lasting 2h30, will be scheduled on 29th, 30th, 31st July and 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th August in the afternoons, from 2.30 p.m to 5.00 p.m. Each workshop is independent from the others in order to enable festival-goers to fully participate.

Object : Animated by professors and directors of repute, these high quality workshops, aim at offering to amateurs worldwide, a specific thematic teaching.

Topics and Directors :

Workshop n° 1 :

« The actor's work according to the Stanislavski method » directed by Michaïl Choumenchenko, Vice-President of the Russian National Centre and theatre professor in Moscow.

Workshop n° 2 :

« Improvisation – an instrument for multicultural performances », directed by Guy Van Sande, stage-director and theatre professor in Antwerp.

Workshop n° 3 :

«Physical and sensorial approach of the actor's deportment» directed by Agusta Skuladottir, stage-director and theatre professor in Reykjavik.

The red and white evening

Not only is the Mondial du Theatre an opportunity for seeing the best troupes perform in Monaco's theatres, it is also an occasion for displaying the artistic vitality, characteristic of the Principality. The Government encourages and promotes, not only the Mondial, but also other prime events, and seeks to diffuse an awareness of the arts on a day to day basis.

Thus, the previous cycles of Festivals have given the opportunity to visitors from over 40 countries, to discover a variety of facets of Monaco's culture : performances by the Monte-Carlo Ballets, a concert by the brass band of H.S.H. Prince Rainier III, an exhibition dedicated to the first Chinese Emperor in Grimaldi Forum, etc..

For this 2005 Festival, in response to a wish expressed by Mr. Rocchi, Director of Cultural Affairs, it seemed worthwhile to highlight the theatrical activity in Monaco, and its talents.

To this end, the Mondial du Theatre will produce a show using the resources of all Monaco theatre companies :

- Studio de Monaco
- La Compagnie Florestan
- La Compagnie Athéna
- Les Farfadets
- The Drama Group

Who will work together on a common and fully shared project.

Given the shortage of time and the different methods and techniques of actors coming from widely different horizons, a professional director, Mr. Yves CARLEVARIS, has been called upon to produce the show. Mr Carlevaris, who is monegasque, was a former member of the Studio de Monaco and pursues a brilliant career in Paris both as actor and director.

The Mondial du Theatre therefore invites us to a special creation : "Grains de Nuit" written and directed by Yves Carlevaris.

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Since last October, the actors have been working under the direction of Yves Carlevaris, and in addition to these rehearsals they have had to honour their commitments to their own company. Nevertheless they all agree that this special and unique project reflects their combined wish to make a success of this "show-window" of monégasque amateur theatre.

Her Royal Highness, Princess Caroline of Hanover, duly appraised of this project by the Prince, has kindly expressed an interest in this production open to participation by all monegasque companies.

This performance "Grains de nuit" will be given in the Salle Prince Pierre de Polignac at the Grimaldi Forum on **1st August 2005** at 20.00 hours on the occasion of the mid-Festival "Red and White" evening.

This evening of recreation will be followed by the Friendship Dinner.



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« Grains de Nuit » by Yves Carlevaris

“All cats are grey in the dark !”. How wrong ! Night alters the perceptions of human beings and things. Extravagance is to the fore. Night breaks down the constraints between human beings who then take on other masks !”

These musings have inspired Yves Carlevaris to write and produce “Grains de Nuit”, a show composed of 10 scenes or tableaux supposedly spanning the length of one Night.

We assist at unexpected encounters between odd and eccentric characters, bizarre or touching (a prostitute dreaming of becoming a dancer; deranged youth with its unpredictable reactions; the “Fraptapp”; a huge transvestite seeking his shoe; a young girl named Daisy who meditates on her identity in a singular manner; the large owner of a hospital who cannot move without an imperial escort of enamoured nurses ! ... The bride carping at her husband in the night, etc, etc ...

The scene is an endless saraband of characters who, with the advent of Night, appear uninhibited and cast off the conventions of Daylight ! Night, represented symbolically by shreds of tulle hanging from the flies ! ...

This spectacle enables all facets of acting to be displayed (comedy, mime, dance, song - music and sound effects being provided by chorus singers).

“Grains de Nuit” will be performed in three languages (English, French and Spanish – each tableau being presented in its own language).

Through the spectrum of the theatre, where freedom of expression flaunts all limits, this performance casts a mocking, violent and tender look on our world.



Symposium of the International Theatre Institute

From 31st July until 2nd August 2005 the Studio de Monaco, national Monegasque centre of the International Amateur Theatre Association (IATA/AITA), organises together with the 13th edition of the Mondial du Theatre, World Festival of Amateur Theatre, the XXVII World Congress of the International Amateur Theatre Association (IATA/AITA).

The delegates visiting the Principality for this Congress are encouraged to attend the performances, and will thereby be able to appreciate the quality and diversity of amateur theatre throughout the world.

This presents an opportunity for the Monegasque Centre of International Theatre Institute (ITI) to invite European branches of the Institute to meet in Monaco, with the triple aim to :

- Hold a symposium of European ITI centres on the topic of : “**convention for the Safeguard of immaterial cultural inheritance: which right balance to find between protection and freedom of creation ?**” – In what measure does not the necessary protection of the immaterial cultural patrimony risk to be an obstacle to the freedom of creation ? What railings to introduce so that the protection of the traditions does not block either their evolution or their interpretation?? This symposium, animated by André-Louis PERINETTI, Honorary president of the iTi, will offer a space of reflection to the delegates of the iTi and the aita-iata.
- Allow ITI European delegates to assist at part of the debates of the International Amateur Theatre Association Congress
- Offer delegates of both associations a venue for meetings and discussions.

The meetings of the International Theatre Institute (ITI) will be held from 31st July until 2nd August 2005.

The symposium will be held on **Tuesday 2nd August 2005** at the Grimaldi Forum and is open to everyone.
